Parent Update and Selection Information

HYBRID ATTENDANCE MODEL:

We will have two distinct cohorts of students. Each cohort will attend school in-person two days per week and will participate in remote learning three days per week. This puts our building capacity at 50% which will allow for social distancing in all classrooms at all times on in-person attendance days. For in-person days, all buildings will run a full, regular schedule which includes electives and specials. Students will be provided with independent learning materials (both hard copy and digital) for remote learning days. Students will also have scheduled remote learning time with staff members on remote learning days.

FULLY REMOTE ATTENDANCE MODEL:

Students who are unable to attend in-person will experience remote learning daily. Schedules will be provided for daily instruction. Independent learning materials (both hard copy and digital) will supplement daily instruction. Students will have the opportunity to participate remotely in most specials and electives. Younger students will need more adult support for a fully remote learning model. Coordination for the exchange of materials may need to take place. Remote learners must be available during regular school hours for direct instruction. Schedules will be provided.



All students will receive Tier I MTSS learning around social/emotional well-being on Wednesdays.

We will revisit our plan every ten weeks and adjust accordingly.

Families will have the opportunity to adjust their selections based on new offerings or other changes at that time.

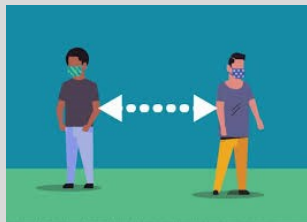

Safety Practices

- ⇒ Staggered school day entrance, exit and transition times to limit numbers of students in hallways.
- ⇒ Added lunch times or lunch provided in classrooms to minimize number of students in cafeteria.
- ⇒ Increased cleaning and sanitizing protocols, especially of highly frequented areas.
- ⇒ Masks worn by all staff and students. Mask breaks provided when safely can do so.
- ⇒ Training in best practices around hand and respiratory hygiene.
- ⇒ Daily screening tool for students and staff.
