**Subject: Resignation and Dismissal**

A Board member may resign at an annual district meeting at which time the resignation shall be automatically accepted. At other times his/her resignation must be presented to the Superintendent of the District, who will endorse it and pass it on to the Clerk of the Board. It shall become effective when accepted by the Board.

A Board member may be removed from office by the Commissioner of Education for willful violation of any provision of law, neglect of duty, or willfully disobeying any decision, order or regulation of the Commissioner.
