**Subject: Storage and Disposal of Hazardous Waste Materials by “Small Quantity Generators”**

Any public agency which generates more than 220 pounds of waste in the forms of petroleum sludge, degreasers, carburetor and engine cleaners, photographic chemicals, mineral spirits, spent solvents and rust removal compounds within one month shall be designated as a small quantity generator and shall not store more than 2,200 pounds of such substances at one site and must use government approved containers and labels when transporting such materials.

A special permit must be obtained for storing more than this amount, and the excess must be disposed of within ninety (90) days at a government authorized disposal site by a waste transporter certified by the State Department of Environmental Conservation.

Any public agency that generates less than 220 pounds of waste must also adhere to proper disposal procedures.
