Subject: School Bus Safety Program

The safe transportation of students to and from school is of primary concern in the administration of the school bus program. All state laws and regulations pertaining to the safe use of school buses shall be observed by drivers, students and school personnel.

The transportation supervisor, in cooperation with the principals, has the responsibility of developing and publishing annually safety rules to be followed by drivers and passengers, including rules of student conduct. In order to ensure maximum safety to those riding school buses, it is necessary that students and drivers cooperate in this effort.

All buses and other vehicles owned and operated by the School District will have safety inspections, in accordance with State requirements and will be serviced regularly. The transportation supervisor will maintain a comprehensive record of all maintenance performed on each vehicle in accordance with State requirements.

All accidents, regardless of damage involved, must be reported at once to the transportation supervisor.
