**Subject: Fundraising by Students**

Fundraising projects in which students sell merchandise, provide services, or in other ways raise money may be sponsored by school organizations or teachers with the express approval of the Building Principal. Local vendors will be given preference when fiscally prudent. Any such plan shall have a clearly defined purpose and the plan must not conflict with instructional programs. Fundraising activities away from school property shall be held to a minimum.

Door to door sales projects undertaken by any organization or teacher, which use the Williamson Central School name shall require previous approval of the Building Principal. Profits of fundraising project shall be used to enhance school programs by providing money for expenditures not normally funded by the District, or to benefit local charities. Fundraising for charities not locally based shall be kept to a minimum and shall require the approval of the Superintendent.
