Subject: Curriculum Development and Supervision

The Williamson Central Board of Education supports and encourages development of a district-wide, articulated curriculum that conforms to state mandates and is responsive to the needs of children in a rapidly changing society. The principals of the elementary and secondary schools and the Assistant Superintendent for Instruction shall be responsible to the Superintendent for developing district-wide efforts toward the short and long-range improvement of curriculum and instruction. In addition, the building principals shall be considered as the instructional leaders in their buildings and, as such, shall be responsible for supervising the instructional program to assure that the educational services provided to the children of the district is of the highest quality possible.
