Subject: Guidance Program

A district plan for the K-12 guidance program shall be filed in the district office and made available for public review. This plan shall be subject to annual review and revised as necessary in the following areas:

- (a) Identification of guidance program objectives (objectives should be student oriented);
- (b) Activities to accomplish the objectives;
- (c) Identification of staff members and other resources to accomplish the objectives;
- (d) Provisions for the annual assessment of program results.

The K-6 portion of the plan shall be developed and implemented to:

- (a) Prepare students to effectively participate in their current and future educational programs;
- (b) Help those students exhibiting any attendance, academic, behavioral or adjustment problems;
- (c) Educate students concerning avoidance of child sexual abuse, acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), drug and alcohol abuse and prevention of child abduction.
- (d) Encourage parental involvement.

The 7-12 portion of the plan shall include the following activities and services:

- (a) Each student's educational progress and career plans will be reviewed annually either individually or in small groups;
- (b) Instruction at each grade level to help students learn about various careers and career planning skills;

- (c) Other advisory and counseling assistance which will benefit students such as helping students develop and implement postsecondary education and career plans; helping those students exhibiting any school behavioral or adjustment problems; and encouraging parental involvement;
- (d) The services of personnel certified or licensed as school counselors.
