President Michael Collins opened the December 14, 2011 meeting of the Williamson Central School District Board of Education with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence. Nicholas Vitalone, Student Representative, reported that high school students have participated in bell ringing for the Salvation Army at Eastview Mall, caroling at Blossom View Nursing Home, and that the musical auditions will take place soon. Wendy Havens recognized the curriculum coordinators for their work on the Common Core Standards. Gary Barno recognized the monitors and staff of the Middle School cafeteria for the great job they during the lunch periods.

Board Committee Reports included updates on Report Card Night, the Elementary Holiday Concert and Musical, National Honor Society Induction Ceremony, PTSA meeting, and the 5th & 6th Grade Holiday Concert. The Board reviewed the Academic Achievement Report, Fall Sports Report and Treasurer's Report and approved several CSE cases. Under the Consent Agenda, the board approved the appointment of substitute teachers, a volunteer and an accompanist for the Elementary School musical.

Under Old Business the board approved the second readings of Policy 6120 – Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances (School Personnel) and Policy 7420 – Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances (Students).

New Business items included further discussion of the items to be included in the proposed capital projects. Todd LaBarr, President, Watchdog Building Partners, participated in the discussion and answered several questions from the board. Following the discussion the board approved the following items:

- Resolution for Abolishment of Position and Reduction in Work Force for one (1) 1:1 aide position effective December 30, 2011, due to efficiency and economy
- A six-week extension to the probationary period for Amanda Johnson, Bus Monitor
