President Michael Collins opened the August 6, 2008 meeting of the Williamson Central School District Board of Education with the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence. He then opened the public hearing on appropriating up to \$100,000 from the Repair and Reserve Fund for the purpose of removal and follow-up remediation of three underground fuel storage tanks at the District Office/Middle School Complex. The fuel storage tanks were discovered when work was being completed for parking lot repairs. Due to the presence of fuel, it is necessary to follow strict clean up procedures that require specialized handling of the contaminated soil around the tanks. The proposed \$80,000-\$100,000 cost includes the removal of tanks, hauling away of contaminated soil and backfill in the places where the tanks were removed.

Board Committee Reports included updates on the recent Board Work Session which was very productive. Mr. Collins commented that it was a very successful session and he congratulated the administration and all of the teams and individuals in the District who have been working hard to continue to support Williamson students and their learning.

Several CSE Case Summaries were approved and the Board approved the Resolution to appropriate up to \$100,000 from the Repair and Reserve Fund for the purpose of removal and follow-up remediation of three underground fuel storage tanks at the District Office/Middle School Complex.

Under New Business, the Board also:

- Approved the appointment of Bridget Coon, Middle School Science Teacher
- Approved the appointment of Joanna Alexander as High School Permanent Building Substitute for the 2008-2009 School Year
- Accepted the resignation of Dawn Prince, Special Education Teacher
- Approved the appointment of Jill Smyth, as a Long Term Substitute for Robin Mason
