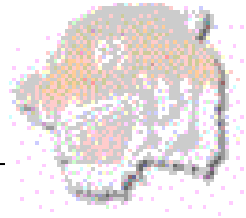

The Williamson Central School District Board of Education held a Finance Committee meeting prior to the regular meeting on July 31, 2013. At the Finance Committee meeting, the Board discussed the status of the reserve funds and the tax levy.

Under reports from District Administrators, Gary Barno reported that the bond note sale took place and the district received a favorable rate. Superintendent Macaluso reported on the administrative workshop that was very successful, his recent trip to Albany for new superintendent orientation and that he continues to meet with district employees as he outlined in his entry plan. Under Board Committee reports, Angela DeFisher reported on the Parks Committee meeting. The board approved several CSE Case Summaries.

Wendy Havens presented the Annual Report and reported that additional information would be provided at next week's board workshop. Terry Pulver, Director of Facilities and Gary Barno reported to the board on the condition of the soccer field. Mr. Pulver reviewed the construction of the field, the restrictions in applying weed control per NYS law and the maintenance schedule. He highlighted that while the field may appear in poor shape in the spring, conditions do improve during the summer months. This schedule allows for good playing conditions throughout the entire soccer season.
